"FARSIMA" is a Farsi language class, founded in 2023 and taught by Sima Jahan(Wagner), an instructor with 25 years of experience. Located in the Dallas-Fort Worth area, the program offers an immersive learning experience that not only teaches the Persian (Farsi) language but also provides students with valuable insights into the culture, history, and geography of Iran and other Farsi-speaking countries.

The curriculum focuses on developing skills in reading, writing, speaking, and conversation, with special emphasis on the Persian alphabet and the foundational structure of the language. FARSIMA, Farsi Class is open to students of all ages—children, teenagers, and adults—and welcomes individuals from any background. It serves as a gateway to discovering traditional Iranian customs, cultural values, key historical events, and the diverse landscapes of Iran.

1- Academics and Participation Policies:

- The duration of the **class is 1 hour**. In the class, the instructor will review the previous homework and provides the new materials, and end of each session, usually provides Iranian games or activities relate to the lesson topic.
- Parents should download any recommended apps for specific learning activities for the class. Weekly class reports and homework will be posted on your WhatsApp application. Parents are responsible to review these updates, read the teacher's notes, and monitor the completion and submission of their students' homework and projects.
- Students must maintain a respectful attitude toward the teacher and the classmates.
- Important information and weekly FARSIMA Farsi Class requirements will be sent to families at least two days before each class. It is the responsibility of each family to read and respond to these messages, confirming that they have received and understood the information.
- Staying in communication with the instructor is important to ensure students are prepared and can fully participate in class activities, and helps us create a smooth and organized learning experience for everyone.
- Families can coordinate with each other to bring healthy snacks or treats, which will be given to the children during break time or at the end of the class.
- Textbooks are provided by the class; however, students are responsible for bringing their own notebooks, black and red pencils, and other necessary stationery items.



- Family plans, such as vacations or travel, must be reported to the teacher **at least 48 hours** in advance. It is the parent's responsibility to arrange make-up classes for any missed lessons due to student absences.
- If a student is unable to attend a class after the monthly payment has been made, parents have a two-week window to coordinate **a make-up class online or on Saturdays and Sundays** with the instructor. If the parents are unable to attend any of the time slots offered by the instructor, FARSIMA will not be responsible for providing an additional class or issuing a refund.
- For group classes, if there is an emergency cancellation, such as illness, the teacher must be notified **at least 3 hours** before the class starts. The class will proceed with a minimum of 2 students. A last-minute cancellation or arriving more than 30 minutes late without prior communication with the teacher will be considered a no-show, and the session fee will still be charged.
- FARSIMA class is not responsible for supervising students during drop-off and pick-up times. It is the responsibility of parents, guardians, or designated drivers to ensure their child's safety. They must park, exit their vehicle, and walk the student across the parking lot. At drop-off, adults are required to stay with the student until a FARSIMA class instructor is present to receive them.

2- Financial Terms and Payment Policies:

Farsi classes are divided into two parts: one focused on Farsi writing, reading, and grammar, and the other on speaking. Sessions can be held *privately, online, or in groups*.

a) Group Class for learning Farsi Alphabet and speaking:

- **Group Class Schedule:** The Farsi class will be held once a week (4 classes per month).
- **Session Fee:** Each class costs \$25 per session.
- **Registration Fee:** An amount of \$50 will be charged at the beginning of each semester (every 9 months).

a) Private Session:

- **Class Schedule:** Each session will be held once a week or more in the student's home or library, based on the contract with the teacher.
- **Session Fee:** Each session costs \$40 per session (75 minutes).
- **Registration Fee:** An amount of \$50 will be charged at the beginning of each semester (every 9 months).



b) Online Session:

- **Session Schedule:** This session considers as a private class, and each session will be held once a week or more, based on the contract with the teacher.

- **Session Fee:** Each session costs \$25 for kids.

c) Speaking Class: Each session costs \$25 for kids.

- **Session Schedule:** can be in person or online in a group or a private.

Family Payments: The tuition fee for the first sibling is \$25. To support families with more than one child enrolled, each additional sibling will receive a discounted rate of \$20.

Payment Schedule: Payment for the classes collects on the 1st of each month. The monthly payment is due 10 days after the start of each month.

- **Payment Methods:** Parents can choose from various payment options (e.g., cash, Zelle to the email FARSIMA, or Venmo). Following, is a direct payment email for Zelle: farsijw57@gmail.com
